Phoned Mrs Brady to learn of the location in the following summaries of 1985.

- 13 JUN 81 - Passed thru Suez Canal bound for India
- 27 JUN to 4 JUL 81 - In port in India
- 10 JUL to 28 AUG 81 - " " "
- 2 - 6 SEP 81 - In port in Singapore
- 2 OCT - Arrived Jeddah Saudi Arabia

The period 13 JUN to 27 JUN is a long time for transit to India which usually takes about 7 days

The period 4 JUL to 10 JUL does not allow time for transit to VM and back to India

The period 10 JUN - 28 August is an unusually long time for the ship to be in port. Possibly that the ship left & then returned to India, however, the ship was involved in some "incident" with the ship SUMMIT DEW during that time frame (NEI). Mrs Brady thought it was most likely a bumping or scraping incident. Lloyd's survey was requested on the Summit Dew.

There was sufficient time from 6 SEP to 2 OCT for the ship to go to VM & arrive in Jeddah.

Normal transit time from Suez to Singapore is 13 days.
