

1		23 MAY 1983	<p>In June 1982 two separate and unrelated groups of Hmong hill tribespeople who journeyed past the Cua Rang area in Nghe Tinh Province, Socialist Republic of Vietnam (SRV), described sighting a prison area which contained an undetermined number of Cambodian prisoners. Some of the tribespeople, who used the nearby Route 7 in their travel between the Plaines de Jarnes in the Lao People's Democratic Republic (LPDR) and northern Vietnam, were able to get close enough to the camp to overhear conversations which they believed to have been in English.</p>
