SOURCE was a former major of RLA (SGU) at Military region II LONGTIANG HQ, after LAO communist took over he was sent to NA CHONG province of XIENG KHOUANG on 07-29-1975 with 28 inmates moved to prison LONGKAI MUANGKHAM on 02-01-77 until 1978 moved to work on the bridge NAM KAT at PHONSAVAN and he had escaped to MUANG PAKSENG province of LUANGPRABANG on 01-06-1979 and he was recaptured by PLA and sending to LUANGPRABANG's prison on 02-12-1979, moved to attopen on 09-29-1979 working on the road from attopen to PARSE, moved to KM 52 north of VIENTIANE on 01-01-1981, working on the road No 13 from LUANGPRABANG to XIENG KHOUANG province. Fled to THAILAND, AMPHOU SIKHIANGMAI on 11-17-8.

SOURCE allegedly, had seen 10 caucasians ploughing rice field about 7 Km far away from prison camp of NACHONG, <sup>with</sup> his inmates ploughing near by this rice field about 60 meters away from the caucasians, they had worked detail on this rice field from 8 AM to 5 and they had 30 minutes break for lunch, the caucasians had 7 LP police guard, not vietname guard, and his inmates also had 6 LP guard, there were no legs chain or handcuff on caucasians prisoner source said, his LPDR guard had told him that the caucasians were americans prisoner which they had captured them during the war, most of them were pilots, the sighting was occurred 1st time on sept or october 1978 and 2nd time about 20 days later, had seen the same group and the same place.

- source said; LPDR had told him that we had captured american pilots and let them work hard, However your people could do easily

source said that, he had seen BOUNGNADETH a son of general BOUNPONE MARKTHEPHARACK and SOULIVONG (jacque LAGUAY) 6 months later.

the caucasian using 3 men ploughing and 1 man guide,  
the lao inmates using 8 men ploughing and 1 man guide, because LAO were small.

the former capt SOVA LEE TIA had seen <sup>americans</sup> with source, but SOVA was released and lived in PHONSAVAN, did not seem plan to come out of LAOS.

SOURCE had refused to have a polygraph examination in PHANANIKHOM refugee camp.

ANALYST (Soutchan)

Discrepancy - BOUNGNADETH and SOULIVONG arrived prison camp of NACHONG on 08-09-75 - but said he arrived NACHONG prison on 07-29-75, and BOUNGNADETH had arrived 6 months later.

SUB - SOURCE DATA

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was a former 1st Lt of Royal Lao air force T28 pilot, he was sent to seminar Longkai (UG 530-660) province of XIENG KHOUANG, on 11-28-75, source had been the same seminar camp with capt SOULIVONG (Jack LEGUAY).

After requesting from french embassy in Vientiane to have released of Jack LEGUAY, the LPDR did not pay any attention for his released until he had escaped from seminar camp in 1980, but the LPDR had allowed SOULIVONG to see the sport game, to do shopping and picking the parcels up from his wifes at PHONG SAVANH and he had been escorted by LPDR always. SOULIVONG had two wifes in Vientiane one chinese and Lao.

SOURCE had escaped from seminar camp Longkai in January 30-1984. During the period of 8 years detention in XIENG KHOUANG province source had never seen american POWs but hearsay from villager said that after LPDR had captured american pilot and they had sent them to Vietnam right away.
