I had been SD of Long Hai police station belonging to the Police Head quarters in Phuoc Tuy province. I was put in K4 camp in Long Khanh from April 1975 to April 1980.

Following is my account of the camp location and situation during my stay.

A. SPECIAL CHARACTERISTICS OF CAMP K4

a) Before 1975, this camp was the Police Headquarters of Long Khanh province, comprising the environs of the remand center, soldiers' quarters of the 18th Infantry Division and fruit plantation of the late general Le Van Iy.

The camp area covered about 100 sq. hectares, surrounded by the stone walls (2M5 x 2M) which were topped by 2 barbed wire fences of 1.5 meters high. In between the fences was an electric wire fence.

These stone walls were completed in 1979.

b) Camp leader was Security Captain NGUYEN VAN HAM, aka NAM NAM. He was in charge of the camp from 1975 - 1978. From 1978-1979, Security captain Nguyen Van Xuan aka Ba Xuan was the leader.
